



General Rules & Regulations

Section 01: Categories, Team Size & Fees

Section 1.1 Categories

Category	Grade Level
Explorer	05 - 08
Innovators	09 - 12

Section 1.2 Team Size

- Maximum: **4 Members** (There is no Minimum)
- Members must be **Currently Enrolled** in the grade range of their Category at the Time of Registration.
- A Student should only compete on **One Team** in **One Category**.
- A Team should only compete in **One Category**.

Section 1.3 Registration Fee

- Registration Fee for each Participating Student in a **Single Competition** is **BDT 300**.





Section 02: Fair Play, Safety & Disqualification

The purpose of the Competition is to encourage Learning, Creativity, Teamwork, and Good Engineering Practices. Participants are expected to compete Honestly and Respectfully at all times.

Section 2.1: Safety Requirements

Robots or any Prototypes must not include any Component that may endanger Participants, Judges, Volunteers, or Spectators.

The following are **Prohibited**:

- Sharp Exposed Blades or Cutting Edges
- Flames or Pyrotechnics
- Explosive or Combustible Materials
- Hazardous Chemicals
- High-Powered Lasers
- Devices Designed to intentionally Damage another Robot or the Competition Field

Judges may refuse any Robot they consider unsafe.

Section 2.2: Sportsmanship

Participants are expected to demonstrate Good Sportsmanship throughout the Competition.

Examples of Unacceptable Behaviour include:

- Interfering with another Team's Robot or Equipment.
- Intentionally distracting competitors during a run.
- Using Offensive or Abusive Language.
- Ignoring instructions from Judges or Volunteers.
- Unsporting behaviour before, during, or after a Race.





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- Each Robot must remain entirely within its Assigned Course.
- Robots shall never intentionally or unintentionally interfere with the Opposing Robot.
- No participant should **Interrupt** the opponent's Robot or **Push** their own Robot.

A Warning may be issued for a First Offence.

Repeated offences may result in **Disqualification**.

Section 2.3: Robot Ownership

- Robots must be Primarily Designed, Built, and Programmed by the Participating Students.
- Mentors, Teachers, Parents, and Coaches are encouraged to Teach and Advise but must not Construct or Program the Competition Robot on behalf of the Students.
- Judges may conduct a brief Design Interview if they reasonably believe that a Robot has not been Built or Programmed by the Registered Team.

Section 2.4: Rule Violations

Teams may be penalized or disqualified for any of the following:

- Violating the Robot Specifications in Section 03.
- Providing false Registration Information.
- Using Remote Control or Wireless Control during a Run.
- Receiving outside assistance during a Race.
- Deliberately Damaging the Competition Field.
- Deliberately interfering with another Competitor.
- Failing to follow instructions from Competition Officials.





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Section 2.5: Equipment Responsibility

Each Team is responsible for bringing and maintaining its own equipment, including:

- Robot
- Spare Components
- Laptop or Programming Device
- Necessary Tools
- Charging Equipment

The Organizers are not responsible for Damaged, Lost, or Stolen Equipment.

Section 03: Liability & General Notes

- Teams are Responsible for Transporting their own Projects safely to and from the Venue.
- Plagiarized Concepts (direct copies of publicly available Project Tutorials without meaningful Modification/Original Insight) will be **Penalized** or **Disqualified**.
- Teams must remain at their Station during Judging Hours unless given Permission to step away.
- By Registering, Schools and Participants consent to Photography/Videography of the Event for Promotional Use.
- Organizers reserve the right to amend these rules up to 7 Days before the Event; all Registered Participants will be notified of any changes via Email.
